The County of Forty Mile is located in the Palliser Economic Partnership (PEP) region of Alberta. PEP is a regional alliance of communities and agencies in Alberta Southeast that work together to enhance the area's economic well-being. With a population of over 3,500, the County of Forty Mile covers 7,283 square kilometres of slightly rolling hills and deep coulees and is centred between the cities of Medicine Hat and Lethbridge. The County is a vast area bordering the United States to the south and the South Saskatchewan River to the north. #### **OUR TOP INDUSTRIES**



#### Agriculture

There are close to 500 farms throughout the County with the majority of the rural population living in the northern, irrigated areas of the municipality. The County's diversified agricultural economy is based on ranching, dryland farming, irrigated specialty crops, and intensive livestock operations. The high amount of sunshine in the region also makes the County a suitable location for greenhouse operations.



#### Aersopace

In 2014, the Foremost Airport introduced a new training and development centre for unmanned aircraft system (UAS) flights and operations for civil and commercial aviation. The Centre is the first of its kind in North America to conduct Beyond Visual Line of Sight UAS training, research and development. The restricted airspace covers 700 square nautical miles (2,400 km2) up to 18,000 feet above sea level.



#### Renewable Energy

The County of Forty Mile is located in an area very well suited to the wind energy sector primarily due to the high average wind speeds and ready access to transmission lines. In addition, there are hundreds of hectares of farmlands on which to develop large scale renewable energy projects. The region's extensive highway system greatly facilitates the transport of large wind turbines and their components.



#### Transportation

The County is served by Highway 61 crossing the southern half of the County and Highway 3 in the northern portion of the County. Various secondary highways feed into the primary system throughout the County and are part of the Eastern Alberta Trade Corridor. Two airstrips are located within the County in Foremost and Bow Island. The nearest commercial and air freight services are located in Lethbridge and Medicine Hat. CP Rail also provides rail service in the County.
