


Invest In The Town of Bow Island

Agriculture

The Town is surrounded by over 110,000 acres of irrigated farming, which yields a variety of different crops such as beans, potatoes, sugar beets, dill, peppermint, hemp and a very progressive dry land farming economy. Bow Island is home to Viterra Bean Plant, which is a Special Crop Facility, and Spitz International (until July 2018), who kick-started the sunflower seeds processing and packaging sector in the region.



Manufacturing

Bow Island is home to Polycore & Kymax. Polycore produce a Thermoplastic liner that is used in tubing for the Oilfield Industry. Thermoplastic liners are extremely abrasion resistant and chemically inert. Kymax Coatings offers a wide range of coating applications including industry standard epoxies, 100 percent solid epoxies, as well as next generation fast set/low temp curing hybrid plural applications.



Construction

Bow Island has a strong construction sector. TRU-CO Structures Ltd. builds Premium Well-Site Accommodations for the Oilfield Industry. Jayco Builders constructs custom built homes, commercial space, or farm related buildings. Jade Homes develop ready-to-move custom homes with unique design. Hiebert Cabinets and Fine Woodwork construct quality custom cabinets for new homes, home renovations, and commercial uses.



Transportation

The Town of Bow Island is located 60 kilometres southwest of Medicine Hat on Highway 3. A local airport provides use of a 3,000 foot paved, illuminated airstrip. Regional airlines are available in Medicine Hat and international service is available at Calgary International Airport. The Town is located on the main rail line of the Canadian Pacific Railway and near the high load corridor.
