OUR TOP INDUSTRIES



Oil and Gas

With shallow gas and pockets of oil prevalent through the area, the oil and gas industry is one of the main drivers of the local economy. Highway 36, a high load corridor adjacent to the community, leads to major developments in the oil sands. We are also just north of the Trans-Canada Highway making the Village ideally situated for industry transportation and servicing.



Agriculture

Cattle ranching/production, hog production and grain farming of diversified varieties are all major contributors to the economic stability of the area. The region produces coarse grains such as wheat, oats, barley, canola and other oil seed crops of high quality. The Duchess region has also seen an increase in alternative farming and the creation of greenhouse operations.



Manufacturing

Duchess, residing within the County of Newell, is part of a very productive and highly specialized market. The manufacturing cluster within the County provides employment for a great many labourers in the region and creates opportunity to other supporting industries. The County is home to JBS Lakeside, Western Canada's Largest Meat Packing Facility, located in nearby Brooks - just 19 km south of Duchess.



Transportation

Our Village is located 15 kilometres north of the Trans-Canada Highway and is directly adjacent to Highway 36 leading to the rich natural resources in the north. This puts us in a strategic location for provincial commerce. The Brooks Municipal Airport is the closest regional all-weather facility. The nearest commercial and air freight services are in Medicine Hat, Lethbridge and Calgary.
